

Jacque's instructions for STARSS crayons:

You will need:

Old crayons

Star shaped molds

Tin foil

Cookie sheet



Take old and broken crayons, and remove the paper (this gives moms a good opportunity to sit and chat). Break the crayons into small pieces, and place them in foil-lined star molds. Fill the molds until they are about half full. Place molds on cookie sheet, and put them in the oven at 250 degrees for about 10-15 minutes (or until crayons melt). Let the crayons sit for a few hours to cool. When they are ready, pop your multi-coloured star-shaped crayons out of the mold.

Jacque's homemade playdough recipe:

Ingredients

2 ½ cups flour

½ cup salt

6 ounce package of kool-aid

2 cups boiling water

2 tablespoons cooking oil

Combine flour, salt and kool-aid in a large bowl. Mix oil and boiling water together, and add to dry ingredients. Stir. Once together, put it out on floured counter or table, and kneed until smooth. Let it cool. You can store the dough in a large zip lock bag, in or out of the fridge.
